NATIONAL MARITIME ESSAY COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- 1. Essays are to submitted by students enrolled in either 3rd or 4th form at a high school. One entry per student.
- 2. Essays must be 800-1200 words maximum. Essays must be typewritten in English, using Times New Romans font size 12, with double line spacing.
- 3. Essays must have a cover page indicating full name of the student, title of the essay, and word count. Essay submission are to be accompanied by the following: copy of the student identification card, recent photo, contact information, and letter from the high school of their status as an enrolled student.
- 4. Entries missing any of the above information listed will not be considered.
- 5. Essays must be original. Plagiarized entries will be disqualified.
- 6. Co-authored essays will be accepted.

Deadline: Entries must be received by 16 September, 2024.

Essays submitted after the deadline date will not be accepted.

Awards:
